Vision for OT and its MNAs (in next 4- years)

Pre-2000, in a private capacity I was involved with numerous MNAs within our region doing my best to develop individuals through direct athlete training to providing specific coaching programs leading into international events.

Since 2005 I have been involved in the OTU in differing capacities which has given me an insight into the extreme difficulties that our smaller MNAs experience daily which may be influenced via community and cultural relationships, local economic implications, difficulties to access educational opportunities with the associated difficulties in travelling long distances from remote areas to get access to education, training, competition and / or health institutions.

With the lack of technological advancement in many of the remote Taekwondo communities is significant and this cannot be underestimated when considering implementing Taekwondo programs including basic communications.

Other factors that potentially encourage poor outcomes for of MNAs is often the disconnect between local Government priorities Vs Community / MNA needs and expectations that directly influence poor communications for and within MNAs.

More recently I have also had the great honor and pleasure in overseeing, managing, and coordinating the Taekwondo sections within the Pacific Games (PGs) before, during and post the 2015 (PNG) and 2019 (Samoa) PGs and now I'm working closely with Solomon Islands to achieve the same success for them come 2023 PGs. These specific experiences have provided me with the fundamental insights into the inner workings of regional partners like the Pacific Games Council (PGC), local and international Governments and international partners in the resourcing to assist sport at all levels. I have seen firsthand and have a clear understanding of what is required at all levels to ensure that the education, training and support required is provided directly to local enthusiastic individuals who learn to oversee, coordinate and manage these and future events within their MNA and hopefully well into the future.

My ongoing Vision over the next four (4) years is to assist MNAs Capacity for long term Self-Managed success via:

1. Build MNA structures
 - a. Good Governance
 - b. Financial Transparency
 - c. Working Boards, Committees - structures
2. Build Partnerships via Trust
 - a. NOC, Sports Departments, Korean Embassy's,

- Business, utilizing experts as required, other
3. Provide Education and Training for
 - a. Athletes, Coaches, Officials, Administrators, Club Instructors through pathways for all to Build Local Capacity
 - b. Support the growth of Club Instructors to build strong local communities
 - i. Via differing business models
 4. Provide Pathways - Grassroot to Elite
 - a. Participation for all
 - i. Community, Schools, Disadvantaged Groups eg remote, women, disability, marginalized groups
 - b. Events / Teams / Camps, Competitions
 - i. Clubs – Regionals – Nationals - OT Championships - Pacific Games - WT ranked events

The above can be tailored to suit specific MNAs and their needs at the time, over the next 4 years I will commit to working more directly to develop any MNA that wants assistance to gain the above.

MNAs should also have the basic goals to develop over the next 4 years and ensure that their key representatives be in a position to also communicate well with stakeholders, etc.

By all of us including OT as Secretary General I will ensure that we also adhere to the basic organizational principles of a Continental Union (CU) to also provide a clear, trustworthy and progressive structure that supports its members in way possible utilizing as many regional **active people** who know what is required to suit not only their MNA but also this CU to provide the necessary programs that can be assessable to all which provides the essential local capacity building needed and required to be successful long term across our great region.
